SCUBA Crew 2501 has set the dates for the next PADI Open Water SCUBA Certification program. This offer applies to Venturers, Leaders, parents, & family members male or female 14 and older (Youth Members of Crew 2501 have 1<sup>st</sup> priority, then Venturers from other crews and adults can participate if space allows on a 1<sup>st</sup> come 1<sup>st</sup> paid bases. Cost is only \$250.00 per person. Our dive instructor is providing his time at no cost for this class. Price includes everything, the crew pack (study materials), the cost of one certification card application, all equipment rentals, air refills, classroom training, 3 pool training sessions (pool rental & 2 days of open water training.) You should be prepared to provide your own mask, fins and snorkel. (some equipment is available for use) Doug Chalmers, committee chair for Crew 2501 is our PADI certified dive instructor.

The youth, male or female are NOT required to join the Crew but are encouraged and welcome.

Each class size is limited to 8 registrants per class. **Only one**, possibly two classes will be offered this year.

**Dates:** Classroom and pool sessions will be held Sunday Aug 3<sup>rd</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, & 17<sup>th</sup> and are planned to be held at the Elk Grove Park District Pool or North Central College's Pool in Naperville (you **MUST** attend all sessions to get certified)

Open water sessions will be held Aug 23<sup>rd</sup> & 24<sup>th</sup> at Haigh Quarry in Kankakee <http://www.haighquarry.com/> (you **MUST** attend both days to get certified) make up sessions will only be offered during the next scheduled class or by making other arrangements with the dive instructor for a date that he will already be at Haigh Quarry.

**Times:** Classroom and pool sessions will begin at 9:00 am sharp and end at 12 noon  
Open water dives at Haigh Quarry will begin at 8.00 am sharp

**Cost:** \$250.00, make checks payable to Crew 2501
